The most common brass bar grade is CZ121 / CW614N. The addition of lead to this brass specification gives it excellent machining properties and it is commonly used for high speed machining operations or where a component requires intricate machining. Other characteristics of this grade include its good strength, resistance to corrosion and good suitability for soldering and brazing.

Other brass specifications are available conforming to British, European and international standards.
